Angling Permit

Conditions of issue

Safety advice

- Anglers fish at their own risk.
- Any maps or other information distributed by the association are for guidance only. The association takes no responsibility for their accuracy.
- Flotation devices highly recommended, compulsory for Juniors.
- Juniors must be accompanied by an adult.

Seasons

Trout;- 15th March – 6th October Fly fishing only

Grayling; - All Year, but Trotting only allowed in Winter season - 7th October – 14th March

(See **club waters** for variations)

Rules

- Trout Anglers to give way to Salmon Anglers.
- Day permits exclude specifically Salmon and Sea Trout, and any angler taking or attempting to take such fish will render themselves liable to prosecution.
- All Trout under 10 inches shall be returned carefully to the water. Salmon Parr should be carefully unhooked and returned immediately to the water.
- Fishing is permitted one hour before sunrise and one hour after sunset. No night fishing.
- Permits are not transferrable and must be presented at the request of authorized personnel
- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to report suspected contraventions or incidents of pollution to the appropriate bodies.
- All catches, returns, including NIL returns and trophies MUST be notified to the Secretary
- Members shall carry their permit when fishing club waters . It must be produced on demand by Owners or Lessors of Club waters, Water Bailiff, Police, Committee members of DBAA or any other duly authorized person.
- All gates to be shut and no damage done to property, crops, livestock or game. NB. NO fires to be lit. NO Litter, No dogs, No camping.
- Trout and Grayling (within trout season). Fly fishing only. No spinning, bubble floats, fixed spool reels or fixed rods;
- Grayling (outwith trout season).Fly fishing + Fixed Spool or centre pin reels permitted. Maximum 3lb line allowed.
- Any breach of these conditions will result in the immediate cancellation of the permit and individuals continuing to fish thereafter will render themselves liable to prosecution.

CLUB WATERS

RIVER TAY

SOUTH BANK BEAT:- Right Bank only, from opposite Rotmell Burn to Inchewan Burn.

TOWN BEAT:- Left Bank from Telford Bridge Dunkeld to opposite the Inchewan Burn.

ROTMELL:- Left Bank, Rotmell Burn to Dunkeld House.

MURTHLY & GLENDELVINE:- Both Banks

TRONACH to BALDARROCH:- No Grayling Fishing Outwith Trout Season

UPPER SCONE FISHINGS(Stanley):- Left Bank only. Pitlochry Beat:- right from below carpark to white water. Benchil Beat:- Left from below carpark to striped post.

No Sunday fishing on Glendelvine.

RIVER BRAAN

TOWN BEAT:- Both Banks from confluence with River Tay upstream to A9 Road Bridge. (NOTE:- Both Banks from A9 Road Bridge upstream to Inver Mill Lade are excluded. This is Private Water.

HERMITAGE BEAT:- From Inver Mill Lade upstream to Hermitage Bridge. NOTE:- Season ends 30th September. NOTE:- No fishing from Hermitage Bridge upstream to top of Falls.

STRATHBRAAN BEAT No. 1:- Both Banks from top of Hermitage Fall upstream to Trochry.

STRATHBRAAN BEAT No.2:- Both Banks from Trochry upstream to the Giron on the Giron Burn.
